Accept, share and defend

the ideals, objectives, integrity and reputation of Nouvelle Planète. Respect its apolitical and secular character.



Assist one another, share, give advice and communicate transparently. Provide resources and knowledge without any obligation for the counterpart to make use of it.



Treat everyone with respect and dignity. Act beyond prejudices and without any religious, ethnic or gender discrimination. Oppose any form of harassment, intimidation, disregard or abuse.



Lead by example. Behave irreproachably in every situation. Oppose any form of corruption or conflict of interest.



Respect and adapt to, the local conditions, lifestyle and customs.



Avoid putting yourself or someone else in danger



Acknowledge the positive and qualities of your counterpart and build trust. Encourage mutual understanding through exchange without power relations.



Be tolerant and open to criticism. Avoid conflicts.
Embrace the unknown and differences with goodwill.



Act respectfully towards the environment. Consider humanity and nature as a whole.



Pursue efficient, useful and high quality work, while prioritizing volunteering.
